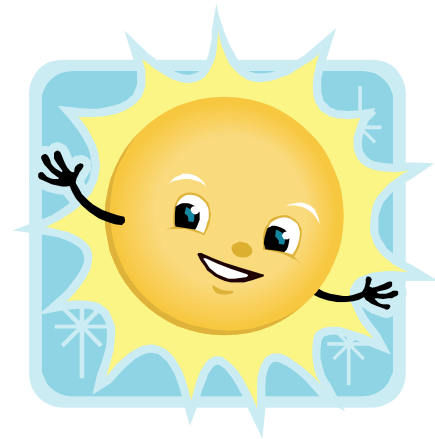

- Provides outstanding leadership in promoting and creating French-second-language learning opportunities for the young people of Saskatchewan
- Celebrates cultural and linguistic diversity in their community
- Provides a positive influence at the chapter or board level

Procedure:

- Nominations must be made by CPF members
- Nominations must be received by CPF-SK on or before March 31st
- Winner will be selected by the CPF-SK Board of Directors
- Winner will receive a three-year membership paid for by CPF-National along with a recognition plaque at the CPF-SK AGM/Chapter Planning Meeting on June 13th
- Form must be completed and signed by two CPF members other than the nominee

Procedure:

- Nominations may be made by students or adults
- Nomination form must be completed with the name and address of the candidate and detailed reason for nomination
- Nomination forms must be received by CPF-SK on or before April 30th
- Winner will be selected by CPF-SK Board of Directors
- Winner will be announced at the CPF-SK AGM/Chapter Planning Meeting on June 13th
- Winner will receive a three year membership paid for by CPF-SK
- The nomination form must be signed by the nominator and Principal or Vice-Principal
